Reynolds Family Winery is located at the southern tip of the Stags Leap District in the Napa Valley on the scenic Silverado Trail. Owned and operated by Steve and Suzie Reynolds, the winery is dedicated to limited production of hand crafted Napa Valley wines. The yellow mustard flower on the label is a symbol of the Napa Valley and the distinctive growing seasons in the vineyards.

This is the second vintage of the Los Carneros Chardonnay that Steve has undertaken. Sourced from the Los Carneros AVA, the Corrotto Vineyard is located near Winery Lake on Dealy Lane. The Los Carneros AVA is nestled between Napa and Sonoma. It boasts a unique climate of marine breezes and low moisture that work in harmony with the rich soil to produce this varietal.

The Reynolds Family Los Carneros Chardonnay is made using non malo-lactic fermentation and it is produced in 20% French Oak. This is a voluptuous round wine that is best served chilled to bring out the tropically bright flavors and accentuate the hints of pineapple and pear. This wine will pair well with apples, nut and cheeses.
